

Prom Guidelines

Eligibility:

- ✓ All individuals attending prom must be no younger than a freshman in high school and no older than 20 years of age.
- ✓ Students failing one or more high school class(es) may not be permitted to attend prom. This also applies for those attending from other schools.
- ✓ Eligibility will be based on cumulative Semester 2 grades.
- ✓ Eligibility will be checked the week prior to prom [when forms are due].

Decorating:

- ✓ The junior class will be responsible for decorating.
- ✓ The junior class will decorate the Friday before prom starting at 8:00 a.m.

Apparel:

- ✓ Ladies shall not be permitted to wear two-piece dresses and/or dresses that show off midriff. Also, the dress should come no higher than the finger tips when the arms are down.
- ✓ Gentleman must dress appropriately in at least a dress shirt, tie, and dress pants.

Grand March

- ✓ There will be grand march practice at the end-of-the-school day, the day before prom.
- ✓ Photo times before the grand march will begin no earlier than 3:30 p.m. and end no later than 7:30 p.m.
- ✓ The grand march will start at 8:00 p.m.
- ✓ Couples will be announced in this order (according to the girl): juniors, seniors, sophomores, and freshman. Class officers will be announced first and the rest will be alphabetical order.

Dance:

- ✓ Two 8th graders will be selected to serve punch during the dance.
- ✓ The juniors are responsible for providing a law-enforcement officer to be present during the dance.
- ✓ Law enforcement and/or school officials are permitted to have and use a breathalyzer if necessary.
- ✓ The dance will begin following the grand march and end at 11:30.
- ✓ All doors (locker room and main doors) will be locked following the grand march. No one is permitted to leave the building during the dance. If someone leaves, parents will be contacted and they will not be allowed to return.
- ✓ The prom advisor, the junior class advisor, and an administrator will chaperone.

Post Prom:

- ✓ The post prom party is the complete responsibility of the students from the junior class and their parents. Upon request, the school may provide transportation to and from the site of the post prom party.
- ✓ The post prom party should start no earlier than 12:00 a.m. and end no later than 4:00 a.m.

Cleanup:

- ✓ Sophomores will be responsible for prom clean-up on the day immediately following prom.
